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In pursuit of mutual interests in the field of research and higher education and as a contribution to the general goal of increased international cooperation, and to promote and intensify the friendship and mutual understanding between the people in general and the two institutions in particular, University of La Plata and the University of Aarhus have agreed to the following articles:



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ARTICLE I: Duration

The agreement is to be in effect as soon as possible after approval by both institutions of the principles and guidelines set forth below. The agreement is subject to periodic evaluation as needed and may be terminated by either institution with six month notice in writing

ARTICLE II: Mutual programmes

The two institutions will promote appropriate joint research projects and joint courses of study. The two institutions conclude mutual programmes in fields of mutual interest. Duration and conditions of such programmes will be determined in specific programme agreements between institutions concerned.

ARTICLE III: Academic exchange

The host institution undertakes to assist in the rent of appropriate housing, the completion of immigration formalities and in supplying work space, library and technical facilities in accordance with technical standards. The parties of the agreement accept to help negotiating with local and national authorities when needed. The two parties undertake to maintain and to promote contacts, with a view to scientific cooperation with other partners in the respective regions.

The duration of each exchange shall be determined in the specific agreement between the institutions concerned.

The home university will continue to pay the appropriate salary to the participant. All the financial issues, including travel expenses, are subject to individual negotiations. Normally, they are responsibility of the academic staff member in question and the home university.

ARTICLE IV: Student exchange

Exchange of graduate and postgraduate students may take place without payment to the host institution of fees other than obligatory memberships of campus organizations. Board and lodging and other expenses connected with the stay in the host country will be at the expense of the visiting student.

Students from either university will be accorded the rights and privileges of student in the host country in accordance with the general regulations in force.



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Full credit shall be awarded by the home university to participating students for the successful completion of an agreed programme.

The number of students exchanged in accordance with Article IV shall be in the range of 2 per year or 4 for one semester each, subject to negotiation in each specific programme agreement.

Proposals of student exchanges are to be made before deadlines agreed in each specific programme agreement. Proposals must be accompanied by a curriculum vitae of the individual student, a statement of qualification from an appropriate faculty member, and a specific outline of the desired programme of study, including evidence of linguistic proficiency and/or plans for the fulfilment of supplementary language requirements, if any.

ARTICLE V: Nomination

Nomination of students is the responsibility of the home university. The host university may at its discretion reject any applicant, whose academic or other qualifications are found inappropriate for the programme in question. However, the exchange shall be based on the principle of mutual trust and confidence between the two institutions and their representatives.

ARTICLE VI: Ratification

The agreement takes effect upon ratification by Vice-President, Lic. Raúl A. Perdomo, The University of La Plata and Rector, Dr. Lauritz B. Holm-Nielsen, The University of Aarhus.

If not previously terminated, the agreement shall be reviewed not later than 2 years from the date of the latest signature, and subject to the agreement of both institutions, it may be extended.

ARTICLE VII: Amendments

Any amendment to or modification of the agreement requires the written approval of both institutions
